

1 Kings: God Proves to Elijah He Is Real 1 Kings 18:1-40



Elijah wants to prove that Baal isn't a real god and that only God is real. He issues a challenge to see whose god can light an altar on fire. The prophets of Baal build and dance around their altar for hours, but nothing happens. Elijah pours water on his altar, and God *still* lights it on fire.

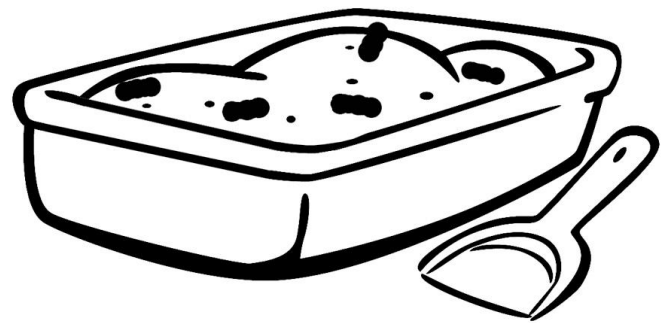


"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path" (Psalm 119:105).

Family Together Time

Make meals or snacks that are impressions of something else. Here are some ideas!

- Use Tootsie Rolls like clay to mold dachshunds.
- Put crisped rice or oat cereal in a pan with a few Tootsie Rolls or molded brownie pieces. It will look like a kitty litter pan!
- Make cupcakes that look like hamburgers.
- Make a "cake" with meatloaf, using mashed potatoes for frosting and steak sauce for "chocolate" drizzle.

- As you eat your food, talk about how even though it *looks* like a real (cake, hamburger, or kitty litter pan), it's actually not.
