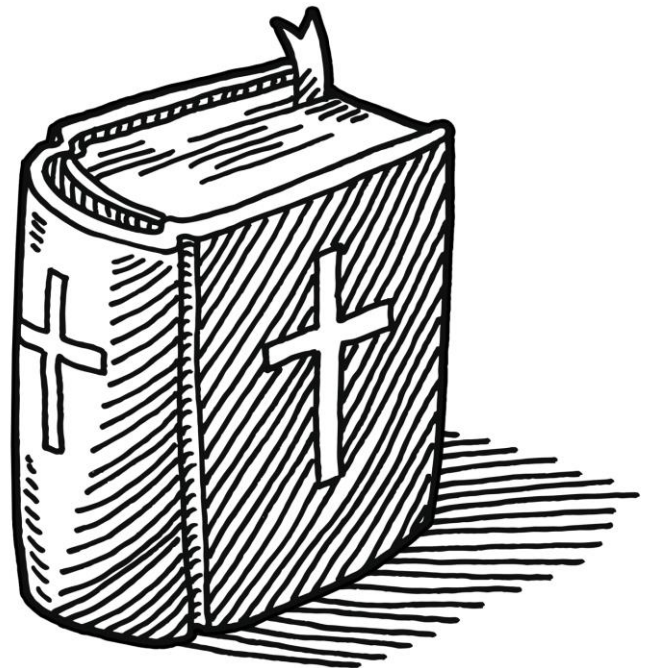


"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path" (Psalm 119:105).

Through the Week

- Read verses as a family every morning. Pray that God will change your day as you keep that verse in mind.
- **Monday:** "Love each other" (John 13:34).
- **Tuesday:** "Keep your tongue from speaking evil" (Psalm 34:13).
- **Wednesday:** "A gentle answer deflects anger" (Proverbs 15:1).
- **Thursday:** "Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too" (Philippians 2:4).
- **Friday:** "Be strong and courageous" (Joshua 1:9).
- **Saturday:** "Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days" (Ephesians 5:16).
- **Sunday:** "Never stop praying" (1 Thessalonians 5:17).

At the end of the day, read the verse again and talk about how God changed the way you faced your day.
