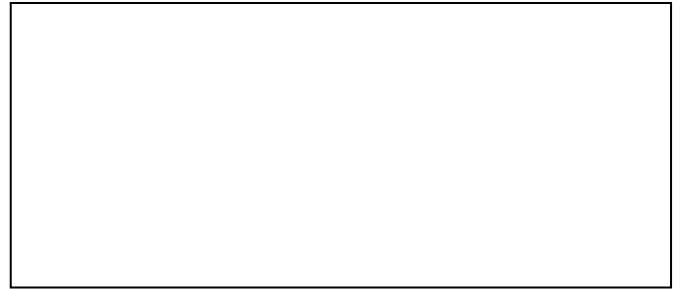

Through the Week

 - “Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me” (basement, crawl space, attic, or other dark place)
 - “You prepare a feast for me” (kitchen)
 - “I will live in the house of the Lord forever” (door)
