



Supplies

- “Outlet Plates” handout, copied onto card stock (1 per child) (download [here](#))
- scissors
- markers

Easy Prep

- Make a sample craft to show kids.
- Pre-cut 1 outlet plate for each child under age 7.



Make Outlet Plates

Show kids the sample craft you made. If possible, tape it to an outlet so they can see how it looks. Give each child an “Outlet Plates” handout or a pre-cut outlet plate. Set out scissors and markers to share, and have kids follow these instructions to make outlet plates.

- Cut out one of the outlet plates on the handout. Remember to cut out the holes, too!
- Decorate the outlet plate with markers. If you can write, make sure you include the word “power” or the point, “the Holy Spirit gives us power,” as a reminder.
- When you finish the first one, make more until time runs out. (Younger kids will need help cutting out additional outlet plates.)
- Hold them up to outlets so you can see what they’ll look like at home.

Talk About It

- Ask:
- **What are some things in your room that are plugged in?**
 - **What do those items do when they’re plugged in?**

Say: **Electric devices need power or they can’t do anything! In the same way, we need power to do big things for God. And the most amazing thing? The Holy Spirit gives us power! Your outlet plates can remind you to “plug in” to the Holy Spirit.**

Have kids take their outlet plates home, tape them to outlet covers, and tell their friends and families about how the Holy Spirit gives us power.
