## Easy Prep

- Make a sample craft to show kids.



## Make Changing Pictures

Show kids the sample craft you made. Give each child a “Changing Picture” handout. Set out markers to share, and have kids follow these instructions to make changing pictures.

- Look at the picture. Then fold it so the arrows touch in the middle to see what the picture will change into. (Younger kids will need help folding.)
- Unfold the picture and color it so that it will look good whether folded or unfolded.
- After you’ve finished coloring, fold it and unfold it to observe the changing picture.

## Talk About It

Ask: • **Which picture do you like better—the folded one or the unfolded one? Why?**

• **How are the two pictures different?**

Say: **Our two pictures show such different things, you wouldn’t think one would change into the other. That’s kind of like Saul. He *hated* Jesus, and he was trying to hurt Christians! You wouldn’t think a guy like that would turn into someone who loves Jesus, travels around the world telling people about him, and writes a lot of the books in the Bible. But Jesus changes our lives, and he can change us in big ways.**

Have kids take their pictures home and show them to their friends and families as a reminder that Jesus changes our lives.
